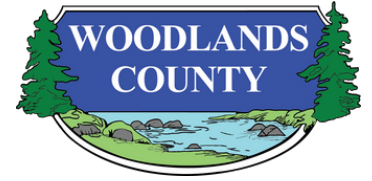


# EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Duties include: Maintenance of all Woodlands County day use and campground facilities including cutting grass, whipper snipping, cleaning outhouses, picking up garbage, painting buildings, installation of signs, picnic tables and fire rings, and the planting and maintenance of flower beds. Provide labour and support during the construction and maintenance of park facilities as required.

Preference may be given to applicants with experience operating lawn maintenance equipment.

### Infrastructure Services Labourers

Duties include: Grounds and road maintenance including sign replacement, pot hole patching, culvert work, road building, flagging, traffic control, line painting, drift removal, operating small equipment and other various labour duties.
