Minimum Qualifications

Our next Aquatic Leaders must posses the following qualifications:

- Completion of some high school or higher education;
- Knowledge of aquatic programs;
- National Lifeguard Award Pool Option.
- Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor Certificate;
- Standard First Aid Certificate;
- C.P.R. Level C;

Shortlisted candidates will be asked to indicate date of issue and provide photocopies of current and up-todate certifications.

Recruitment Process:

- 1. Shortlisted candidates will be invited for skills screening and an interview, which will be held on **Saturday March 8**th, at City Centre Aquatic Complex (1210 Pinetree Way).
- 2. Successful candidates will be required to attend one of two series of dates for <u>mandatory training</u> <u>and orientation</u> at City Centre Aquatic Complex and Poirier Sport & Leisure Complex as per below:

 - b. April 15th, 17th, 22nd, 24th (Tuesday and Thursday) 5 9pm

Preferred Qualifications

- Previous experience working as a swim instructor, lifeguard or aquatic leader in a similar capacity would be considered an asset.
- Other related certifications, such as Pool Operator or Aquatic Fitness, or advanced aquatic certifications such as National Lifeguard Instructor, Lifesaving Instructor or Swim For Life Trainer, would be considered assets.
