What you will do:

- Assists with preparing maps and diagrams for reports and studies using GIS software and other related software applications.
- Assists with preparing graphics and power point presentations for planning reports and studies.
- Assists with preparing reports and correspondence for signature by supervisor(s).
- Assists with a variety of research tasks related to planning feasibility studies, regulation development and policy formulation
- Collect data from drawings and transfer to a database.
- Other related duties, as necessary.
