Under the direct supervision of the Survey Supervisor and Deputy Director of Engineering, you will be responsible for the following assignments:

- Assist in operating a transit and level instruments and participate in the operation and set up of the Total Station and Global Positioning System (GPS).
- Assist in acquiring data for a complete topographic survey.
- Using AutoCAD and Civil 3D in Assisting with preparing engineering drawing and providing feedback to your supervisor;
- Assist with designing roadworks and underground utilities.
- Assist with permit applications
- Assist in preparing Class C and Class A estimates
- Arranging site tours, attending Public Information Meetings, and performing a variety of inspections and tasks when needed; and,
- attend site inspections and field reviews.

Desirable Training and Experience:

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills;
- Strong customer service skills;
- Skilled in the use of Microsoft Outlook, Word, Excel, and PowerPoint;
- Experience with AutoCAD would be an asset; and,
- Ability to work independently with guided supervision.
