The role also involves monitoring and recording pool conditions, maintaining equipment readiness for both regular and emergency use, and upholding good housekeeping standards in all pool areas. Additionally, the instructor will prepare lesson plans and evaluations in advance to ensure effective program delivery.

 - Lifesaving Swim for Life Instructor.
 - Synchronized swimming instruction: BC Synchro Association recognized certification.
 - Springboard diving instruction: BC Diving Association recognized certification.
 - Water polo instruction: BC Water Polo Association recognized certification.
- Compliance with and approval of Security/Reliability Clearance and Criminal Record Search (including vulnerable sector).
- Certification in Standard First Aid with CPR C.
