The successful candidates will conduct customercentric, compliance-oriented patrols of the district by vehicle or foot patrol to enforce the District's Streets and Traffic Bylaw, Boulevard Regulation Bylaw, Parks Management and Control Bylaw and other regulations. The ideal candidate for this challenging role will possess strong observation and communication skills and will handle difficult situations with tact and diplomacy. Attention to detail and proficiency in word processing software and database applications are equally as important.

Requirements include Grade 12 or equivalent; one year of experience in enforcement or regulatory work; experienced in office practices and procedures; possession of a valid BC Class 5 Driver's Licence and a satisfactory Police Information Check no older than 6 months.
