This position delivers professional trade-level service in plumbing and millwright duties, collaborating with the maintenance team to support asset management initiatives and continuously improve preventative and prescriptive maintenance. Acting as a key ambassador for the Municipality, the Millwright/Plumber demonstrates commitment to health and safety standards, provides support on specialized projects, and mentors trade apprentices.
