Job requirements:

- Ability to tolerate extreme heat and humidity which can occur in our kitchens

- Ability to perform other duties as assigned.
- Have a valid Food Safe Certificate, Level 1.
- Must be able to pass and maintain a police information check including vulnerable sector check (PIC-VS)

*You must be available to work a variety of shifts including days, evenings, weekends and statutory holidays. Concession workers may be scheduled to work 3 to 5 shifts per week, each shift is between 2 to 6 hours long. Vacation blackout period is from June 28 – August 4. Please note that shifts are subject to change due to weather, attendance and events. Shifts at an outdoor concession will be cancelled on days of poor weather conditions.
