## **Junior Operator - Lift Stations**

- Learn and execute the process for the maintenance of the wastewater systems.
- Perform assigned inspection, assessment activities and maintenance activities.
- Responsible for assigned repairs to the system infrastructure.

## Qualifications

- A completed high school Diploma or GED and 2 years Utility Experience; OR
- A completed 1 year Technical Certificate in Water and Wastewater (i.e. NAIT) and no experience; OR
- A completed 2 year Water Engineering Technology Diploma (Water and Wastewater option i.e. Okanagan College) and no experience.
- A valid full Class 5 Driver's License (or provincial equivalent) with no more than 6 demerits, and no current suspensions or charges pending.
- Must obtain Level 1 Wastewater Collection Certification within 2 years from the start date.
- Preference will be given to applicants with the ability and willingness to use software and desktop or remote device.
- Education related to drinking water or wastewater systems is preferred.
- Interpersonal and adaptability skills are required for success in this position.

**Working Conditions:** Primarily outside at field locations including excavation sites, manholes, residential streets, above and below ground.
