Key Accountabilities:

Reporting to the Manager of Operations, the Compliance/QMS Coordinator is responsible for creating and maintaining programs and procedures that will minimize the risk of Water and Sewer Department personnel contravening existing Acts, Regulations, procedures, and practices. The Compliance/QMS Coordinator administers the Quality Management System (QMS) by ensuring that processes and procedures needed for the QMS are established and maintained. The Compliance/QMS coordinator also sets procedures and practices to ensure that operation and maintenance are carried out to provide optimum utilization and protection of Water and Wastewater assets.

Skills and Experience:

- Recognized post-secondary diploma in an engineering or environmental program or equivalent technical experience with knowledge of water supply and distribution systems, wastewater systems, and mechanical systems, preferably in a municipal environment.
