We are looking for a qualified individual for a regular part-time position, involving aquatic work in lifeguarding and instructing at an indoor and/or outdoor aquatic facility. An employee in this role performs a variety of operational, instructional, lifeguarding, janitorial, and minor preventative maintenance tasks while offering instructional and recreational aquatic programs for all age groups.

A Lifeguard/Instructor II will carry out these duties in accordance with established practices and procedures, exercising tact and firmness when dealing with juvenile and adult patrons. More complex or unusual matters will be referred to a superior, who will review the employee's performance based on the effectiveness of the aquatic programs and services provided, as well as conformance with established practices and procedures.

Required Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Sound knowledge of the theory and practice of lifesaving, artificial respiration and first aid.
- Working knowledge of teaching methods and group leadership techniques emphasizing instruction in water safety and aquatic skills.
- Working knowledge of pool chemistry, of water filtration, chlorination, heating and related pool equipment and procedures.
- Ability to display sound aquatic skills and to instruct in these skills at standards set by relevant authorities.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with officials, employees and patrons.
- Ability to prepare and maintain records relating to the work.

Qualifications:

- National Lifeguard Award Pool Option (NL)
- Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor certification
- Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation Level C current within one year (CPR C)
- Minimum age of sixteen (16) years.
- Completion of Grade 10 and/or an equivalent combination of training and experience is an asset.
