## Job Overview

The Township of Langley is currently recruiting for up to two temporary full-time **Labourers** (from approx. April 22, 2025 to December 19, 2025) to join our team of professionals in the Public Works Division, Utilities Operations Department, including Wastewater Collections Group. Reporting to the Manager, Utilities Operations, in this unionized position you will perform a variety of manual work requiring physical effort and agility in unskilled and semi-skilled construction and sanitary sewer operations, maintenance and repair tasks.

## Responsibilities

- Perform semi-skilled tasks in utilities operations repairs, construction and maintenance
- Assist with vegetation control and minor sanitary sewer system repairs
- Perform confined space entry in hazardous environments for the purpose of maintenance
- Act as a pad-person/spotter for backhoes performing utilities construction operations
- Break blacktop and concrete surfaces using pneumatic hammer and compressor accessories
- Drive a vehicle to transport materials and tools to and from job sites
- Perform other related work as required

## Qualifications

- Completion of Grade 12 with some experience in construction and maintenance or an equivalent combination of training and experience
- Sound knowledge of the methods, techniques, materials, tools, and equipment applicable to the various functional areas of utilities construction and maintenance work
- Skill in the use of a variety of tools used in general maintenance and construction work
- Sufficient physical strength, stamina and coordination to permit the performance of heavy manual outdoor work in all weather conditions
- Ability to understand and effectively carry out oral and simple written instructions
