As an Equipment Operator – CCTV Inspections, you will operate specialized equipment to inspect and assess the conditions of municipal sewer systems, drainage lines, and other infrastructure using closed circuit television (CCTV) technology. You will be responsible for ensuring that systems are functioning optimally and reporting any issues to the relevant departments for necessary action.

Main duties include, but are not limited to:

- Operate and maintain CCTV inspection equipment to assess the conditions of underground pipes, sewer lines, and other infrastructure.
- Conduct routine inspections, documenting findings and compiling reports on system conditions.
- Troubleshoot equipment malfunctions and ensure the CCTV equipment is properly serviced.
- Ensure compliance with all safety standards and municipal policies while on-site.
- Participate in training and professional development opportunities as required.


