To qualify, you must have completed Grade 12 and possess three years of experience in concrete finishing work. Candidates should demonstrate considerable expertise in the methods, materials, tools, and equipment used in concrete finishing. A strong understanding of the standard specifications related to concrete construction work is also required. Additionally, applicants should have a solid knowledge of concrete mixtures applicable to various projects and under varying weather conditions. **A valid, full privilege Class 5 BC driver's license (or out of province equivalent) is required. This term position is expected to last longer than three months.**
