Plumbing Inspector

Are you a skilled plumbing professional with a keen eye for detail and a commitment to ensuring safety and compliance? Join our team as a Plumbing Inspector! In this technical inspectional and regulatory role, you will be responsible for inspecting plumbing, drainage, and sanitary/storm sewer systems in new and existing residential, commercial, industrial, and institutional buildings. Your work will ensure that all installations comply with applicable by-laws, codes, and regulations. This position requires considerable independence in interpreting and applying codes and regulations, including issuing stop work orders when necessary.

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct inspections of plumbing, drainage, and sewer systems during construction and renovation to verify compliance with relevant codes and regulations.
- Review plumbing plans and blueprints to ensure they meet required standards before approval.
- Collaborate with contractors and property owners to address any code violations or required adjustments.
- Provide technical support and advice to contractors, engineers, and property owners on plumbing installations and compliance.
- Maintain accurate inspection reports, documentation, and records for all projects.
- In cases of non-compliance, issue stop work orders when necessary and follow up to ensure corrections are made.
- Prepare for and participate in legal proceedings related to code violations, including presenting evidence in court if required.

Qualifications and Skills

- Solid knowledge of plumbing systems, including drainage and sewer installations, and the relevant building codes and safety standards.
- Strong attention to detail and the ability to identify non-compliant work or faulty materials.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to explain technical matters to a wide range of stakeholders.
- Ability to read and interpret plumbing plans, diagrams, and specifications.
- Skilled in report writing and maintaining thorough documentation of inspections.
- Ability to work independently, make decisions, and follow up on projects with minimal supervision.
- Must be able to manage multiple tasks and deadlines efficiently.

Preferred Qualifications

- Completion of an apprenticeship in plumbing or a related trade with significant hands-on experience in plumbing inspections.
- BOABC Plumbing Official Level 1 Certification is an asset.
- A valid Class 5 Driver's License for the Province of British Columbia.
