Job Overview

The Township of Langley is currently recruiting for a temporary full-time **Trades 1 – Trees** (from approx. April 25, 2025 – April 24, 2026) to join our team of professionals in the Public Works Division, Parks Operations Department. Reporting to the Manager, Parks Operations, in this unionized position you will be expected to perform semi-skilled arboricultural and/or horticultural work involving the planting of trees, tree watering, pruning and maintenance. You may assign, supervise, and check the work of one or more staff assisting in the more routine tasks and provides training as required; may assign and oversee the work of contractors: ensures safe work practices and environment according to municipal and WorkSafeBC standards.

Responsibilities

- Perform tree related maintenance tasks including pruning, removals, pest control, watering, and planting
- Respond to service requests from the public
- Operation of a truck and chipping machine
- Complete and maintain a variety of records, forms and maps related to the work
- Perform related work as required

Qualifications

- Completion of Grade 12 supplemented by courses in Arboriculture and/or Horticulture plus sound related experience, including some supervisory experience; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Certified Tree Risk Assessor Qualification is desirable.
- Considerable knowledge of the methods, practices, materials, tools and equipment used in arboricultural and related to the work
- Sound knowledge of the names and varieties of a wide variety of trees, plants, shrubs and flowers, their characteristics and requirements and the application of an integrated pest management program
- Ability to provide routine information to the public and provide follow-up to their complaints and enquiries
- Ability to assign, supervise and check the work of one or more staff and provide training to same

This position is defined by the Township of Langley as a position of trust (Child Safety). The successful candidate(s) will be required to have a Police Information Check as a condition of employment (Note - Not required as part of the application process, however will be required upon consideration for employment).

Required Certifications/Licenses

Candidates **must** have the following valid and **current** certifications/licenses (must be valid at the time the posting closes) and these **must** be attached with your application.

- BC Class 5 (full privilege) Driver's License. You must include with your application a current **Personal Driving Record (select the 5-year option if obtaining online)** that has been obtained within 6 months of the closing date.
