Our Inclusion Support Leaders will prepare and deliver individualized lesson plans and support materials, modify and reinforce instructions to provide guidance and assistance, adapt activities to reinforce learning introduced by the program leader as well as assist in the delivery of recreational programs as directed. Communicating with participants and their caregivers as well as providing guidance and advice will be expected.

Qualifications

Successful candidates will have completed high school as well as completion of a certificate or diploma in therapeutic recreation, disability and inclusion, education assistance, behavioural intervention, or other related discipline. Some related experience is also expected. Candidates must have a Driver's License for the Province of BC (with satisfactory driving record) as well as valid first aid and CPR certifications (minimum Emergency First Aid with CPR B).
