As the successful candidate, you will oversee on-deck employees engaged in lifeguarding, swim instruction, special events, and various janitorial and preventative maintenance tasks. You will play a crucial role in developing our aquatic staff by providing guidance, feedback and ongoing training to ensure a high level of customer service and adherence to safety standards.

Your strong communication and relationship building skills will be essential as you provide instruction in a variety of aquatic and related programs. In addition, you will participate in regular on and off deck rotations and ensure all staff are rotating and starting swim lessons on time.
