Qualifications include Grade 12 and a minimum of one year of experience working with the public requiring enforcement of rules and regulations. Formal Training in conflict resolution and customer service is also required. Familiarity with parking control, bylaw enforcement, court and adjudication processes and experience working in a regulatory field enforcing regulations and gaining compliance are considered assets. You possess excellent interpersonal skills to courteously interact with the public as well as the ability to work independently. As a condition of employment, this position is required to obtain and maintain a clear Police Information Check for offences related to the position. A valid full privilege class 5 BC driver's license is also required (or out of province equivalent).
