The SCRD's vision is to support a healthy and vibrant Sunshine Coast with sustainable and affordable services and innovative partnerships. Led by the CAO, our team provides a wide array of regional services with a combined annual operating budget of about \$67 million, a capital budget of \$68 million and has a positive and supportive work culture.
