Security Infrastructure Specialist

Two (2) Permanent, full-time positions Salary: \$78,624.00 - \$98,259.00 based on a 40-hour work week. Work location: 600 William Street, Cobourg, Ontario.

Reporting to the Security Infrastructure Supervisor, the Security Infrastructure Specialist provides cost effective security systems maintenance including locksmith services, to provide informed recommendations and direction on future security improvements and mitigate risk by responding to potential or existing security concerns quickly.

The Security Infrastructure Specialist is responsible for overseeing wire installations by telecom contractors for larger CCTV / card access projects and coordinating with electrical contractors where power is necessary for security equipment to operate.

Major Responsibilities:

- Provide locksmith specific maintenance services and new installations;
- Create new key matrixes and maintain existing key systems, duplicate keys and cut new keys from code;
- Create replacement keys for desks, drawers, other miscellaneous locks where keys have been lost;
- Maintain various door hardware items including panic bars, door closers, mortise and cylindrical locksets;
- Rekey/re-pin new and existing lock cylinders;
- Install new door hardware in both residential and commercial environments;
- Install and maintain various automatic door openers / accessible washroom hardware;
- Provide security integration specific services and new installations;
- Maintain keyless entry systems such as proximity reader, keypads, wireless button/receiver combinations etc;
- Troubleshoot and diagnose issues with the previously mentioned keyless systems including power supplies, faulty readers and keypads, etc;
- Install new security equipment integrated into existing security infrastructure such as adding card readers to new additional sites or adding hardware to existing sites;
- Install, maintain, and repair various CCTV systems including I.P., TVI and Analog systems;
- Run/drop cables for various projects such as CCTV, access control, etc.

Qualifications & skills:

- 3 years experience in a locksmith/security integrator role
- Certification from a locksmith training academy (e.g. TAOL) would be an asset.
- Experience installing door hardware including electric strikes, door closers, automatic openers etc. Experience with basic electrical circuits would be an asset.
- A thorough understanding of mechanical lock mechanisms including mortise, cylindrical, adams rite narrow style, and LFIC lock systems etc)
- An in-depth working knowledge of basic electrical circuits used in access control such as normally open/closed circuits, timed relays, power supply limitations, etc)
- A comprehensive understanding of various CCTV elements such as I.P. camera programming including bitrates, compression types etc. Different CCTV protocols such as IP, analog, TVI etc.
- An understanding of access control functionality including access levels, schedules, panel addressing, panel/electric strike power requirements, etc.
- A basic understanding of device networking to collaborate with I.T.
- Access control applications include RBH AxiomXa, Rosslare, and KABA Ilco, Camera applications include HikVision, Dahua, Inaxsys, Axis, and Pelco.
