The work involves considerable public relations contact and requires the exercise of independent judgment, action, tact and diplomacy within policy, regulation, and bylaw limits. This position reports to the Bylaw Services Manager who oversees the City's enforcement operations. The Animal Control Officer will provide support to the Bylaw Enforcement Officers when required.
