Reporting to the Director of Operations, the Engineering Project Manager is a key member of our collaborative leadership team providing technical and strategic advice on capital initiatives. The Engineering Project Manager performs complex and diverse engineering and project management work, including the design and oversight of mid-to-large scale capital projects. The role requires the application of sound engineering principles and project management practices to deliver successful, practical, and sustainable outcomes for our community.

Recognizing the unlimited potential of this vibrant community and the importance of hiring a leader to assist Council in achieving their strategic goals and objectives, as outlined in the <u>2023-2026 Strategic Priorities Report</u>, we are looking to attract a collaborative, results-oriented leader as the Engineering Project Manager.

The core job duties include:

- Lead the planning, design, and execution of municipal engineering projects, ensuring they are completed on time, within scope, and on budget
- Oversee the upcoming <u>municipal wastewater treatment plant upgrade project</u>
- Support the preparation of the department budgets, monitor assigned budgets and control costs ensuring the effective and efficient expenditure of allocated funds
- Collaborate closely with the executive leadership team, Council, and external agencies on all capital initiatives
- Provide expert technical advice and strategic guidance to the Director of Operations, Chief Administrative Officer (CAO), and Council
- Ensure that projects comply with applicable legislation, municipal policies, Council-approved procedures, and industry standards
- Coordinate with consultants, contractors, and stakeholders to facilitate effective communication and project outcomes
- Manage and maintain comprehensive municipal engineering records and documentation
- Provide temporary coverage of Public Works operations as assigned

The ideal candidate will have:

- A minimum of a Diploma from a Civil Engineering Technology Institution and post-secondary education in Project Management
- Membership or eligibility for immediate membership as an Applied Science Technologist (A.Sc.T.)
- A minimum of five (5) years of experience in a municipal environment or equivalent experience in the private sector
- Excellent knowledge of the philosophies, principles, and practices of municipal civil engineering, construction, and construction contracts and MMCD

- Ability to interpret and apply legislation
- Proficient with Microsoft Office including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Project and Outlook
