Reporting to the Park Development Services Manager, this position will play a crucial role in planning, developing and maintaining the City's extensive park system. This position will be responsible for:

- Liaising with Contractors and Developers regarding park interests and requirements on land development projects
- Performing inspections of land development sites and ensure park requirements are being met
- Reviewing and providing comments on development plans and drawings, including civil drawings, arborist reports, environmental reports, and landscape drawings
- Performing Tree Risk Assessments
- Developing cost estimates and other technical reports
- Managing programs and projects within approved budgets
- Prepare and execute restoration or treatment plans for upgrades to parkland
- Coordinating and supervising work of contractors and crews related to parkland upgrades

QUALIFICATIONS
