We are seeking a highly motivated professional with a diploma in Civil Engineering Technology and eligibility for certification as an Applied Science Technologist (AScT) in British Columbia or an equivalent out-of-province designation. For the Development Services Engineering Technologist 1 role, candidates must have Grade 12 completion, a two-year post-secondary Diploma of Technology or Technician Certificate from a nationally accredited program recognized by ASTTBC, and at least two years of experience in a civil engineering environment. The Development Services Engineering Technologist 2 level requires the same educational background and a minimum of three years of relevant experience. For the Development Services Engineering Technologist 3 position, candidates must meet all previous requirements and have at least five years of experience, along with an AScT designation. A valid full privilege Class 5 BC driver's license (or out of province equivalent) is required.
