Job Summary

Reporting to the Director People & Culture, the People and Culture Generalist supports human resources administration and programming. The role provides support to the Director People & Culture including HRIS, labour relations, recruitment, policy development, compensation, health and safety, benefits, disability, attendance management, training and development, and enhancing the employee experience including wellness.

Experience & Qualifications

- Minimum of a College Diploma in Business Administration, Human Resources or Labour/Industrial Relations or related field **required** (University Degree is preferred)
- Minimum of three (3) years recent and relevant experience in a Human Resources Generalist role

- Certified Human Resources Professional (CHRP) designation required (Certified Human Resources Leader (CHRL) designation would be an asset)
- Recent experience working in a unionized environment interpreting collective agreements required
- Health & Safety Certification or the ability to complete requirements within one (1) year of assuming the position – required
