The role: Reporting to the RCMP Municipal Manager and working directly under the supervision of the Restorative Justice Coordinator/Acting Victim Services Coordinator, the Temporary Victim Services Support provides temporary administrative and crisis intervention support to the Victim Services Program, which provides crisis intervention and immediate follow-up assistance to victims and witnesses of crime and trauma.

Flexibility in scheduling work hours will be involved in this position. The Temporary Victim Services Support is expected to work with minimal supervision. This position is exempt from the provisions of the City of Campbell River/C.U.P.E. Local 401 Collective Agreement and is employed as a temporary contract position with the potential for extension upon mutual agreement. The Temporary Victim Services Support is expected to supply their own vehicle on the job within the contract allowance.

What we offer: The rate of pay for this temporary part-time position is \$28.56 per hour, based on a work week of up to 30 hours, as agreed with the City's RCMP Municipal Manager.
