Candidates are required to pass an audiology exam in accordance with NENA Hearing Standards for Public Safety Telecommunicators. It is essential to maintain composure and control during difficult situations while handling calls in a courteous, confidential, and respectful manner. A valid Class 5 BC Driver's License (or an equivalent from another province) is required. The successful candidate must also be able to obtain and maintain a clear Police Information Check for offenses relevant to the position.
