Reporting to the Operations Supervisor, the Equipment Operator provides support to the Township's Public Works & Property Department with safety as a priority.

Position Qualifications:

- Valid DZ driver's license (minimum) in good standing with an AZ License being desirable.
- Must have completed O.S.S.D. (Grade 12) or CAEC.
- Must have experience in operation of tandem trucks, backhoe, loader and other miscellaneous equipment.
- Operation of tandem snowplow and snow removal equipment is considered an asset.

- Must possess knowledge and understanding of the Occupational Health & Safety Act.
- Must be available for on call and ability to work flexible hours.
