Manager of Recreation and Culture

Reporting directly to the CAO, the Manager of Recreation and Culture will be responsible for managing all aspects of Recreation and Cultural programming, facilities, and staff in the Department. The Town's facilities include a Recreation Centre (with gymnasium, youth lounge, kitchen, weight room, meeting rooms, seasonal swimming pool, and squash court), an Arena, four playgrounds, two baseball fields, a skate park, the Campbell Region Interpretive Centre (which is the Town's seasonal tourism and cultural facility), an RV Park, an Arboretum, a Cross-Country Ski Chalet with adjacent trails, two Sheep-Lookout cabins and many kilometers of multi-sport trails. The ideal candidate will have excellent organization and communication skills, supervisory experience and a passion for creating events and activities that serve the community and tourists to the area.
