QUALIFICATIONS

The successful candidate will meet one of the following criteria:

- Completion of Grade 12, supplemented by the successful completion of five additional relevant courses from an approved post-secondary institution, plus 2 years recent experience in landscape maintenance and/or landscape construction
- Completion of Grade 12, supplemented by a Technical Certificate Program (one-year full-time) from an approved post-secondary institution, plus 18 months of recent experience in landscape maintenance and/or landscape construction
- Completion of a diploma program from an approved post-secondary institution, plus a minimum of 6 months recent experience in landscape maintenance and/or landscape construction

You must also:

- Have a valid BC Driver's License with a safe driving record
- Obtain a Pesticide Applicator's License prior to completion of probation period
- Obtain Arborist Certification through the International Society of Arboriculture prior to completion of probation period
- Be able to complete heavy manual labour in all weather conditions is an asset.
