Reporting to the Development Planning Manager, this is an intermediate level professional planner position with a considerable level of experience and expertise to undertake a wide range of planning assignments of moderate to high complexity with some responsibility to mentor junior planners.

- Preparing, researching and providing analysis on a wide range of planning issues.
- Reviewing, negotiating and processing complex land development applications.
- Responding to development enquiries from Council and the public.
- Preparing comprehensive reports with recommendations to Council and preparing correspondence to the public.
- Drafting comprehensive development (CD) Zoning Bylaws.
- Coaching and mentoring junior planners.
- Other duties include conducting site inspections.
