- Assist with preparing and writing Grant applications, summary reports.
- Develop and maintain strong collaborative relationships with Community based Senior Services, local and provincial governments, and City staff from all departments.
- Recruit, train and supervise staff including the Age Friendly Volunteer Ambassadors.
- Provide solution-oriented customer service to older adults, partners and the Age Friendly project team.
- Assist with other administrative tasks when necessary.

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Qualifications

Successful candidates will have:

- Graduated from a recognized university or college level program plus 2 years progressively responsible experience in recreation, including supervision.
- An equivalent combination of relevant training and experience will be considered.
- A current Emergency First Aid and CPR C certificate.
- A valid BC Driver's License with a safe driving history.
- The ability to exercise good judgement and work independently.
- Strong public and interpersonal skills.
- Working knowledge in Gerontology, Therapeutic Recreation, Health Wellness or Medical systems is an asset.
- Experience in project planning and event management is also considered an asset.
