This position is responsible for completing complex street operations, ensuring safe work practices, and providing guidance and direction to junior operators and crew members. The successful candidate must have the following qualifications:

- 1. Completion of senior secondary school or its equivalent.
- 2. Valid BC Driver's Licence Class 1 with air brake endorsement (for operating a tandem with pup).
- 3. Minimum of one year's previous experience driving a tandem axle vehicle in city traffic and confined spaces, including three months' experience operating a roller, loader, and backhoe for road construction.
- 4. Minimum three months' previous experience in municipal road construction, including 500 hours of municipal operating experience on a grader.
