The City of Campbell River is seeking an experienced Planner to join our Long Range Planning Team as either a **Planner I OR Planner II** in this 16 month term position.

Naturally, Campbell River – Located on Vancouver Island, the City of Campbell River offers a rare combination of a welcoming small-town feel with large-city amenities. We are a 45-minute drive from the winter and summer activities of Mount Washington, and just minutes from more than 100 km of all levels of mountain biking and hiking trails, plus easy access to the ocean, rivers and lakes for sports fishing, kayaking, paddle boarding and whale watching.

The Roles: As part of the Long Range Planning team, you will be working in a fast-paced and customer service orientated environment.

- **The Planner I** supports long-range planning projects through research, analysis, and assisting with policy development. The role assists with reports, studies, and public engagement, applying planning knowledge to land use and growth initiatives. The Planner I works independently on routine tasks and consults with the manager on complex or sensitive issues.
- **The Planner II** plays a key role in leading a variety of long-range planning projects and initiatives. The Planner II will conduct research and analysis, prepare detailed reports and policy recommendations, draft and update bylaws, and lead public engagement activities. Acting as a project manager, the successful candidate will provide technical advice, and collaborate with internal teams, external partners, and the public to help shape the community's future.
