Core Responsibilities

Perform winter night patrol on a seven-day-a-week rotation basis, including:

- Patrol roadways and monitor weather and driving conditions.
- Complete detailed road surface condition reports and determine if winter maintenance is required in accordance with Ontario Minimum Maintenance Standards (O. Reg. 239/02) and Township Winter Control Policy.
- Patrol all roadways for deficiencies outside of Winter Minimum Maintenance Standards.
- Operate a pickup truck plow/sander for snowplowing and sanding/salting of primary roads.
- Maintain assigned vehicles in a clean and tidy condition; perform daily inspections and record deficiencies. Make minor repairs as required.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

During emergency situations, perform other labour-related duties, which may include:

- Removal of fallen trees across roadways.
- Installing barricades for road closures or detours.
- Picking up debris on the roadway.
- Streetlight inspection and reporting.
- Minor sign repairs.
- Responds to after-hours calls from the Call Center.

Applicant must comply with all health and safety practices, standard operating guidelines, and the Occupational Health and Safety Act. Wear personal protective equipment as required and report hazards to the Supervisor.

Qualifications & Skills

- Ability to work flexible hours, including nights and weekends.
- Minimum Grade 12 education or equivalent.
- Must have a valid "G" driver's license.
- Demonstrated experience operating snow plow equipment with at least one year of road patrol experience.
- Chainsaw training considered an asset.
- · Valid Ontario DZ driver's license in good standing considered an asset.

Work Schedule

- Six-month contract
- Rotation: 4 on / 3 off and 3 on / 4 off over a two-week period
- 80 hours per pay period (two weeks):
 - Week 1: Four (4) 11-hour shifts (44 hours).
 - Week 2: Three (3) 12-hour shifts (36 hours).
- Shifts: 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM.
