Reporting to the Manager of Cybersecurity, the Cybersecurity Analyst will play a crucial role in protecting the province's digital infrastructure by monitoring, identifying, analyzing, responding and mitigating cybersecurity threats. The role requires a deep understanding of cybersecurity principles, strong problem-solving abilities, and the capacity to work in a fast-paced environment. This individual will assist in the implementation of the security processes and procedures while meeting the required service level agreements (SLA).

The ideal candidate has relevant experience and education in the field of Cybersecurity, has experience with implementing and administering Cybersecurity program for organizations that can be scaled and replicated.

Qualifications & skills:

- Post-secondary degree or diploma in Computer Sciences and/or 3 years of relevant experience or equivalent combination of training and experience.
- Certified in Cybersecurity ISC2 (CC) or equivalent is preferred.

- Lead the technical response to cybersecurity incidents, including the coordination of efforts across various teams and assist with the communication to the stakeholders.
- Conduct regular security audits and prepare vulnerability assessment reports to identify potential risks and recommend enhancements.
- Collaborate with other governmental agencies, partners, and vendors to ensure a mature security posture.
- Internal & external network penetration testing (KALI) experience is an asset.
