This role is important because the experiences children have at camp contribute to their self-esteem, social development, and sense of belonging. As a primary caregiver and mentor throughout the day, you will create a positive, inclusive atmosphere while ensuring the health, safety, and well-being of all participants.

We are looking to fill 2 term positions, based on 40-hour work weeks, Monday - Friday:

### Responsibilities

- Provide leadership and act as a positive role model for participants.
- Supervise participants throughout all activities.
- Engage participants in a positive and encouraging environment.
- Plan, facilitate, and adapt programming.
- Be familiar with the medical conditions, dietary restrictions, and/or behavioural concerns of participants and act according to information and training provided if needed.
- Ensure that safety standards and procedures are maintained.
- Report any accidents/incidents to the Recreation Program Facilitator.
- Assist in cleaning up after activities and at the end of each day.
- Adhere to and promote the City of Wetaskiwin's health and safety program, and all policies, procedures and directives.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

### Skills, Abilities, and Requirements

- Demonstrate excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Knowledge and understanding of recreation service delivery and customer service.
- Able to work independently and as part of the team.
- Applicants must be between 15-30 years of age as these positions are partially funded by the Canada Summer Jobs grant and are subject to funding approval.
