This management position is responsible for:

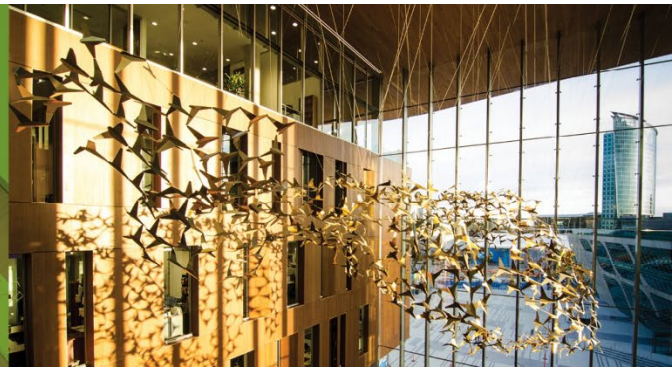
- Developing long range plans and program frameworks within specific functional areas of the Recreation Services Division.
