You demonstrate the ability to safely and efficiently use tools and operate equipment, recognize and address safety hazards, and follow detailed oral and written instructions. A valid WorkSafeBC Occupational First Aid (OFA) Level 1 certification is considered an asset. **A valid, full-privilege Class 5 BC driver's licence (or out-of-province equivalent) is required. As a condition of employment, the successful candidate must obtain and maintain a clear Police Information Check related to the position.**
