## Project Engineer

As a Project Engineer, you will be responsible for project management of various design and construction projects within Utilities Delivery. Primary duties include:

- Design and manage construction of infrastructure at landfills and other facilities, including preparation of construction drawings, obtaining all required approvals, materials listing and tendering specifications for construction contracts.
- Report on projects including progress report, tangible capital asset, and work breakdown structure.
- Develop Terms of Reference and direct consultants involved in studies and projects related to Utilities Delivery infrastructure and asset management.

### Qualifications

- A degree in Engineering.
- You must have at least 3 years of relevant professional engineering experience obtained after receiving your P. Eng. Designation and a current licensure as a Professional Engineer with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Alberta (APEGA) **complete with practicing status** OR licensure and **practicing status** by the first day of work. - Experience in civil engineering design and environmental engineering projects is required.
- Training or practical experience in solid waste management, environmental monitoring and data interpretation is also required.
- A valid Class 5 Driver's License (or provincial equivalent) with no more than 6 demerits, or a Class 5 Graduated Driver's License (GDL) with no more than 4 demerits, with no current suspensions or charges pending.
- Access to a personal vehicle for occasional business use is required.
- Previous experience with project management, and/or asset management will be considered an asset.
- Strong analytical skills, accuracy and attention to detail.
- Excellent communication skills and demonstrated leadership, negotiation and time management skills.
- Ability to obtain a City of Calgary [Operator's permit](#).

**Working Conditions:** Occasional site visits will include exposure to odors, traffic, and various weather conditions.

- Successful applicants must provide proof of qualifications.
