- Participate in the planning of utility systems including water, wastewater, and storm water infrastructure;
- Prepare cost estimate for projects; and,
- Other assignments as required.

- Skilled in the use of Microsoft Office, including Outlook, Word, Excel, and PowerPoint;
- Experience in GIS and AutoCAD would be an asset; and,
