**EXPERIENCE:**

- Must have two (2) years of work experience operating landscaping and grounds maintenance equipment including but not limited to: tractors with implements, utility vehicles, mowers.

**SUPERVISION:**

**CONDITIONS OF WORK:**

- Work will be carried out in all types of weather conditions while constantly under the eye of the general public in municipal parks, city buildings and street site locations.
- This work requires considerable physical effort to work in extreme hot, extreme cold and all types of stormy weather conditions.
