

Instructor Leaders Auxiliary Employment - Summer Camps

Are you looking for an exciting summer job with an opportunity to work with a great team and deliver summer programming for groups and youth? Then come join the City of Campbell River in the Recreation Department's Summer Camp Programs as an Instructor Leader.

The role: As an Instructor Leader, you will be working as part of a team, and will facilitate, lead, support and participate in a range of activities and events for young children (5 & under), children (6-11yrs) and/or youth (12-18yrs) in our summer camp programs. You will ensure the safety and care of all participants, and promote an inclusive, welcoming environment. It is a great opportunity to learn new skills.

What we offer: The rate of pay for this short term auxiliary CUPE bargaining unit position is **\$24.97** per hour, plus 12% in lieu of benefits (this is equivalent to a wage of \$27.96 per hour). The successful candidate(s) will also have access to a reduced cost Employee Wellness Pass for Recreation facilities and programs.

Workplace culture is important to the Recreation Department - we are looking for people to join us who embrace our core values of teamwork, respect, integrity, communication and kindness.

Our ideal candidate must have:

- Minimum of Grade 10
- Minimum of three (3) months volunteer or work experience facilitating programs, activities and/or sports for children (5 & under), children (6-11yrs) and/or youth (12-18yrs).
- Experience in a Leader-In-Training program or equivalent is considered an asset.
- Possess and maintain a valid Emergency First Aid Certificate with CPR C-AED.
- Ability to successfully attain a clean criminal record and vulnerable sector check prior to the start of employment.

Season: The season for these short-term auxiliary roles typically starts in July and ends in late August working full-time hours. The successful candidates will be required to attend training week that runs June 29 to July 3, 2026.
