You have completed Grade 12, hold a college certificate in Horticulture or a related discipline, and have a valid Pesticide Applicator's License (Landscape General). A Worksafe BC Occupational First Aid (OFA) Level 1 certification is also advantageous; if you do not have it, you must complete the training within six (6) months of being hired. Additionally, you should have one year of directly related horticulture experience along with one year of experience in the use of herbicides, pesticides, and fertilizers. **A valid Class 5 BC driver's license (or out-of-province equivalent) is required, along with a clear Police Information Check for offenses related to the position.**
