Primary accountabilities include:

- Perform hands on municipal water/sewer infrastructure installation and repairs
- Install and replace pipe, water services, hydrants, mainline valves, manholes, etc.

- Flush sanitary and storm systems
- Safely operate heavy equipment including tandem dump truck, various loaders and various light duty vehicles
- Carry out other water/sewer/storm repairs and maintenance as required

- High School Diploma or GED
- Two (2) or more years' experience in municipal water/sewer infrastructure installation and repair is considered an asset
- Valid Class 3 driver's licence with Q endorsement is required
- Valid Class 1 motor vehicle licence would be considered an asset
- Standard First Aid and CPR would be desirable
- Level 1 Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection certification from Alberta Environment and Protected Areas would be considered an asset
