You have completed Grade 12 and hold a valid 4th Class Power Engineer Certificate or higher in Boiler and Pressure Vessel Operations. Valid EOCW Wastewater Collections and/or Treatment certifications are considered an asset. You bring a minimum of three (3) years of related power engineering experience, with district energy experience preferred. Experience in wastewater collections and treatment is also considered an asset, along with knowledge of HVAC systems, SCADA, and HMI operations. **As a condition of employment, the incumbent must be able to obtain and maintain a clear Police Information Check for offenses related to the position, plus additional security to permit access to sensitive buildings with various security requirements. A valid full-privilege Class 5 driver's license (or out of province equivalent) is also required.**
