Reporting to the Supervisor of Turf and Golf, the Greenskeeper is responsible for turf grass and plant material maintenance programs, personnel management, scheduling and maintenance of irrigation systems, pesticide applications and their related recordings and compliance of regulatory issues. The Greenskeeper is responsible for developing and overseeing a maintenance master plan and to provide agronomic direction for Golf Operations. The Greenskeeper will communicate with all golf staff regarding daily activities and promote a team approach throughout Golf Operations. From December through February, the Greenskeeper will be transferred to Parks Services where they will be required to work in various operational areas of the Department as may be necessary.

Qualifications
