A Level 1 First Aid certification is preferred, or the ability to obtain certification within six (6) months of hire. The successful applicant will have knowledge of CSA Playground Structure Guidelines, be certified to operate a tractor equipped with a 72-inch mower, and possess a sound understanding of horticultural and turf grass principles, gardening, landscaping, and park maintenance. Thorough knowledge of the methods, practices, materials, tools, and equipment used in turf grass, landscape, and building maintenance is required. **You must possess a valid Class 5 BC Driver's License (or provincial equivalent) and be able to obtain and maintain a clear Police Information Check relevant to the position.**
