SCOPE

Reporting to the Fleet & Garage Manager in Engineering Operations, the incumbent will perform skilled trade tasks involving considerable physical effort and active performance in maintaining, servicing and repairing a wide variety of multiple fuel type vehicles and equipment.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform a variety of tasks including mechanical overhaul, maintenance, servicing, and repair on a wide variety of equipment from light duty automotive vehicles, dump trucks, excavators, snowplows, salt spreaders etc.
- Inspect and troubleshoot equipment with the use of diagnostic equipment to determine cause of malfunction.
- Carries out repairs and servicing of vehicles and equipment including engines, transmissions, differentials, hydraulic components, brakes, suspension, and winter maintenance items.
- Fabrication of components, welding, and repairs to components
- Interacts directly with internal customers and crew members.
